

## Reading

Read with your child every day for 10 to 15 minutes. This will help them develop a word bank which they can use in their school work.

Reading is very important and aids your child's knowledge of punctuation, sentence structure and story structure. Your child will learn more effectively if they read more at home.



## Spelling & Homework

Homework will be sent out during the second week of each half term. Please support your children in completing at least 2 activities from each section. Spellings will be given on a Tuesday and children will be tested the following Tuesday.

## Computing

Our topic this half term is '**Communicating Clues**'.



The children will be challenged to solve a mystery by reading, sending and replying to emails and by listening to a witness statement. They will use a fact file sheet to create a table and identify the suspect.

They will also continue to reiterate the importance of using technology safely and respectfully, as well as protecting personal information when online.

## Religious Education

We will be learning about Sikhism and focussing especially on the Sikh Gurus.

Talk to your child about your own religious beliefs and answer their questions.

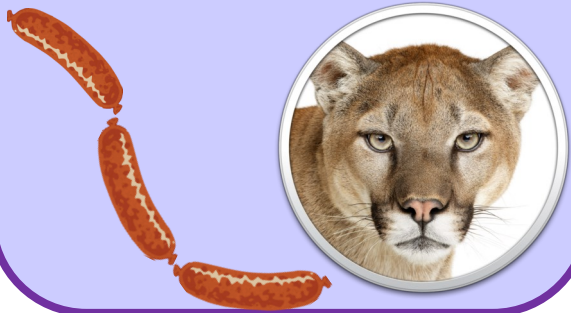

## English

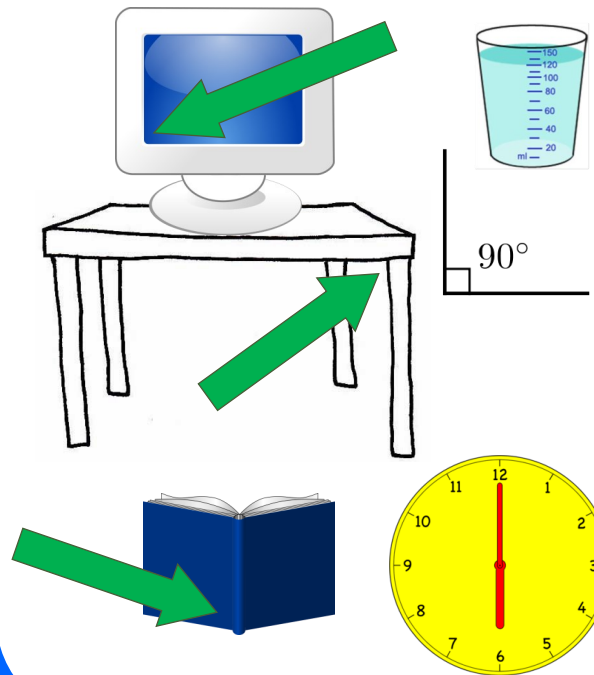

## Mathematics

In Mathematics children will decide which calculations are needed to solve a two-step problem. We will recognise patterns in different number sentences and solve problems involving time.

We will learn that a quarter turn makes a right angle, find right angles in the classroom and use quarter and half turns to make patterns.

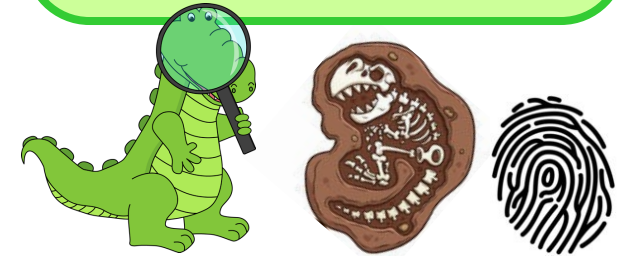
We will learn that a litre is 1000 millilitres and read different scales.
