

Maths


Choose 1 or more to complete:

3. Take ten cards numbered 0-9. Each time use all ten cards. Arrange the cards to make:
 - a) Five numbers that are multiples of 3
 - b) Five numbers that are multiples of 7
 - c) Five prime numbers
