The Government believes that the Pupil Premium, funding for which is additional to main school funding, is the best way to address the current inequalities by ensuring that funding to tackle disadvantage reaches the students who need it most.

The Pupil Premium for 2012-13 has already been allocated to schools. It has been for schools to decide how the Pupil Premium is spent since they are best placed to assess what additional provision should be made for the individual pupils within their responsibility

New measures have been included in the performance tables that capture the achievement of those deprived pupils covered by the Pupil Premium. From September 2012, schools are also required to publish online information about how the premium has been used.

2012-2013

The school received £157,200 for the Pupil Premium. It was used to fund the following areas:

- Specialist teaching (1:1 and 1:3 groups in Literacy and Maths)
- Smaller class sizes for identified cohorts for Literacy, Maths and Phonics
- Pastoral care interventions including Breakfast Club (Early Birds)
- Funding for high quality and healthy school meals
- Two Netbook trolleys
- Accelerated Reader books

The impact of the additional funding can be seen below

Phonics – 45% year one pupils entitled to FSM working at required standard. (65% Haringey)

78% FSM children achieved L4+ in Reading, Writing and Maths (66% Haringey Average)

11% FSM children achieved L5+ in Reading, Writing and Maths (11% Haringey Average)
