

## **PE and Sports Premium Funding**

The government has announced that it is providing additional funding of £150 million per annum for academic years 2013 to 2014 and 2014 to 2015 to improve provision of physical education (PE) and sport in primary schools. This funding - provided jointly by the Departments for Education, Health and Culture, Media and Sport - will be allocated to primary school head teachers. The money must be used to improve the provision of P.E. and school sport.

### **Intended Outcomes**

Improving the quality and breadth of PE and sport provision. Well planned and competently delivered curriculum with the use of coaches/teachers where required.

All staff are trained in delivering high quality PE sessions.

Increasing participation in PE and Sport so that all pupils develop healthy lifestyles and reach the performance levels of which they are capable. (Emphasis on positive attitudes towards Healthy, Active Lifestyles)

### **Funding will be used to enable The Devonshire Hill Primary School to:**

- Buy into the CPD offer for Physical Education and School Sport in Haringey 2014 – 2015
- Purchase Kandu playground markings and supplementary equipment for the Key Stage 1 playground. (Already in place)
- Purchase fixed trim trail equipment for the school field. (Summer 2015)
